



Grant Request FAQs

Q. Am I required to utilize the Zogenix Grant Request Form?

A. Yes. The Grant Request Online Form must be completed in full for consideration. (In the case of charitable contribution requests, please see below).

Q. Why is an Educational Needs Assessment required?

A. The Educational Needs Assessment establishes the basis for the Educational Objectives and Program Topics. The needs assessment may include an educational gap analysis, survey of the target audience, previous program evaluations, results of focus group discussions, expert opinion, and/or literature searches.

Q. What types of organizations are deemed eligible for consideration?

A. Academic institutions, medical societies, CME/CE providers, hospitals, patient advocacy groups, and community-based organizations.

Q. Do you provide grants to individuals or physician practice groups?

A. No.

Q. What are some examples of non-allowable grant expenses?

A. Non-allowable expenses include:

1. Payment for food and beverage expenses
2. Promotional activities related to Zogenix products
3. Normal administrative overhead and expenses
4. Travel, lodging, or financial remuneration for a healthcare professional to present a paper or poster
5. Marketing sponsorships or exhibit opportunities – grant requests that include marketing sponsorships or exhibit opportunities will be automatically denied
6. Educational activities for which the attendee (either patient or healthcare provider) is paid by the meeting organizer (e.g., scholarships and travel vouchers)

Q. Do you accept charitable contribution requests?

A. Yes. Please be cognizant of our current area(s) of interest. You may utilize the Grant Request Form and additionally please include a Support Prospectus.

Q. Can a grant request be updated after it has been submitted?

A. Yes. Any changes or additional attachments should be emailed to: grants@zogenix.com.

Q. How long will it take for a decision to be made?

A. The Grants Committee typically meets on a once monthly basis.
